MEXICO MISSION PACKING LIST

- Passport
- Temp-appropriate sleeping gear: sleeping bag, pillow, blankets, cot or sleeping pad or air mattress (cot or air mattress optional, but highly recommended)
- Tent (and stakes to keep it secure in case of wind)
- Propane tent heater (not necessary, but a luxury!)
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, shower shoes, ear plugs etc.)
- Towel for shower
- Toilet paper
- Flashlight and/or headlamp
- Water bottle with your name on it
- Camping chair (with your name on it)
- Hat and sunglasses
- Sunblock, lip balm
- Hand warmers (not necessary, but nice to have)
- Work gloves
- Tool belt or nail pouch
- Work shoes (close-toed) & clothes. Pants strongly recommended at the worksite. T-shirts, no tank tops. Keep in mind that clothing and shoes may get stained or ruined so pack appropriately. Lots of socks.
- Comfortable clothes for back at camp
 - Check weather and pack temp and weather appropriate clothes for day and evenings. (Occasionally, rain gear and a warm coat are necessary)
- Bible, journal and pen
- Garbage bags
- Cell phone portable charger
- Any personal tools you would like to use over the ones provided (ie. hammers, handsaws, jab saws, utility knife, shovels, etc. Please do not bring power tools).
